# Assessment Increase Proposal

The Lake Timberline Board of Trustees has approved a Proposal to increase assessments to begin in the new 2025 fiscal year.

This proposal is to be voted on by property owners.

Ballots will arrive in September for your vote.

After consideration and discussion, a majority vote was taken of a motion to equalize assessments for each lot owned to \$185.

**Primary lots** would see a \$20 increase or (\$1.66/mo.)

Please Vote YES

**Secondary lots** would see a \$70 increase or (\$5.84/mo.)

Please Vote YES

These proposed increases seem, but are not excessive.

We are Lake Timberline and we need your support.

Goose Creek has assessment and fees totaling over \$400.

Terre Du Lac assessment range is \$269 to \$675 + fees.
